Paint Pouring Beginners & Intermediate with Rae Gray on 13th May, 2024 10.30 - 1pm £35.00pp. Try Paint Pouring with Rae Gray using good quality paints, pouring mediums, canvasses and silicone oil. Paint pouring is an art form that anyone can try. Each student will be able to create 3 pieces of art during the session. These can be collected 3 days after the class when dry. Includes tea and coffee. Wear old clothing/coverall/shirt or a full apron. Limited to 8 places.



Make this mixed media owl wall hanger using Powertex with Purple Meadow Arts & Crafts on Saturday 1st June, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm. £45.00pp. Using an MDF base you will be creating your owl plaque by using an environmentally friendly fabric hardener, materials and embellishments. You will be shown how to create textures and layers that will give it its own individual look. It will then be dried whilst you relax with tea and coffee provided. There is a choice of colours to paint your work and bring it to life using a dry brush painting technique.



Make a Sterling Silver Wordy Bangle with Kate Snookes on Friday May 17th, 2024 10.30 - 3.30pm £98.00PP. 8 Places Includes all materials. A favorite phrase, song lyric or motivational words for yourself or someone else? Then why not come along and translate them into a beautiful bangle so you or a loved one can read those words whenever they wish. Words and/or symbols can be stamped on the inside or the outside or both. There is room for roughly 15 words on each surface. We will be using traditional silversmithing tools and techniques, all materials and tool use included in the price, suitable for absolute beginners and above, all welcome.



Learn to paint Canal Art roses with Stuart Garfoot on Sundays 4th or 11th August, 2024 10.30 - 2.30pm. £40.00pp. 6 places at session. Includes use of all materials, paints and equipment.
