

A **stained glass workshop** - create a colourful, abstract piece of stained glass with **GILLIAN WING** of **STRAWBERRY GLASS** - **Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2016**

Includes use of tools, safety equipment and materials. Minimum age 16 yrs and is unsuitable for pregnant women/nursing mothers. The technique was developed in the Tiffany Studios using copper tape and solder to make the seam joining the pieces of glass. You will work in a relaxed environment with plenty of individual attention and there will be a large selection of coloured and textured glass pieces to choose from. At the end of the day you will take your handmade piece home with you to display.

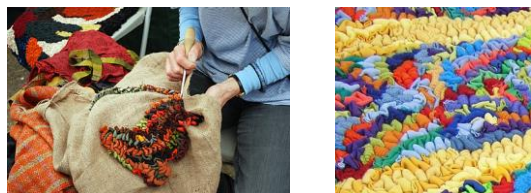
