






Create Vivid Sunflowers with inks and watercolours with artist Karin Christensen on Sunday 5th May, 2024 10.30 -

Paint a Donkey in acrylics with artist Amina Sly-Khan on Saturday 20th April, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm.

Students will design their bird bath from a selection of patterns and then will learn how to cut glass/grind glass to form the main elements and fill in the background. You will need to be able to stand for the morning.
