

Paint Pouring with Rae Gray on 13th May, 2024 10.30 -

1pm £35.00pp. Try Paint Pouring with Rae Gray using good quality paints, pouring mediums, canvasses and silicone oil. Paint pouring is an art form that anyone can try. Each student will be able to create 3 pieces of art during the session. These can be collected 3 days after the class when dry. Includes tea and coffee. Wear old clothing/coverall/shirt or a full apron. Limited to 8 places.

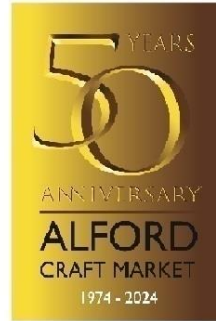
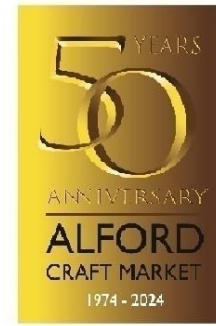

We will look at composition and colour blends. You will practice this technique before you create your own piece of art to take home with you. Your finished piece will be A4 in size, mounted onto a good quality mount board with a frame insert. Includes all materials. tea or coffee



Make a Spring Fascinator with Yvonne Cunnington on Friday 19th April, 2024 10.30 - 2.30pm. £80.00pp. This very unusual class includes all materials. 4 places. In this workshop you will learn how to make a sinamay fascinator from scratch, and take it away with you at the end of the class to wear at your own special event/wedding/garden party etc.



Join Monika Strzelec learning to make a Macrame Wall Hanging on Tuesday 30th April, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm. £40.00pp. Join this Macrame workshop for beginners to learn the beautiful craft of Macrame in a relaxing and friendly atmosphere. Paint a Donkey in acrylics with artist Amina Sly-Khan on Saturday 20th April, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm. £40.00pp. Paint a donkey in acrylics. The session is artist led and is suitable for all levels, whether you are a beginner, a dabbler or intermediate. After introductions we begin layering the acrylic paint to create a background. The donkey will be drawn for you on A3 top quality paper. Once the background is painted we start painting the donkey. Acrylic paint is a beautiful medium which is very forgiving. Includes all materials, tea and coffee. **Make a ceramic Green Man with Amina Sly-Khan on Saturday 20th April, 2024 2pm - 4.30pm. £50.00pp.** Hand build the green man using slab work. Gradually build the face using leaf like shapes, vines etc. to give the green man plenty of character. The finished piece can be used as a beautiful and unusual piece of garden art. The size of the green man is approximately 30cm in diameter. Includes all materials, tea and coffee.



Make a terracotta and glass mosaic bird bath with tutor Claire Hart on Thursday 25th April, 2024 10.30 - 5.30pm. £62.50pp. All materials provided. 6 places at each session. Size approx. 30cms in diameter. Students will design their bird bath from a selection of patterns and then will learn how to cut glass/grind glass to form the main elements and fill in the background. You will need to be able to stand for the morning.

Make a Powertex birdhouse with Purple Meadow Art & Crafts on Saturday 4th May, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm. £40.00 Purple Meadow's powertex tutors will guide you through the process of making your own fabric sculpted birdhouse, suitable to put outside, by using environmentally friendly powertex and natural embellishments /material. After creating your texture and design, you will then be shown how to add your chosen colours, by using pigment paints and a dry brush painting technique. Your birdhouse will be fully functional and eatherproof when fully cured. The birdhouse will add something a little different as well as colour to your garden.



Create Vivid Sunflowers with inks and watercolours with artist Karin Christensen on Sunday 5th May, 2024 10.30 - 3.30pm. £40.00pp. Come and play with inks and watercolours while we create some vivid sunflowers. We will practice different techniques for mixing inks and watercolours, and also create various interesting textures. Did you know there are 70 different kinds of sunflowers? Today we will take inspiration from these and go a little crazy with the shapes and colours. Great if you want to loosen up and just enjoy yourself. Open to everyone. All materials provided.

Paint a Hare in watercolour with artist Amina Sly-Khan on Sunday 12th May, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm £40.00pp. Using watercolour pan paints, use vibrant washes of colour to paint a hare full of character. The hare is drawn for you as this is a watercolour painting session. You will be guided step-by-step through the process of washes, wet on wet, wet on dry etc to paint your own hare on top quality watercolour paper. The classes are small, there is a maximum of 8, so there is plenty of 1-1 tuition and guidance available. What's included?? All materials, tea & coffee, small class.
