The session is artist led and is suitable for all levels, whether you're a beginner, a dabbler or intermediate. After introductions we begin painting a background in acrylic paint. Once this is completed we start to create a stunning poppy in the style of Georgia O'Keefe. Acrylic paint is a beautiful medium which is very forgiving. The painting is on A3 top quality watercolour paper. Includes all materials and tea or coffee.



Make a ceramic Green Man with Amina Sly-Khan on Sunday 25th February, 2024 2pm - 4.30pm £50.00pp. Hand build the green man using slab work. Gradually build the face using leaf like shapes, vines etc. to give the green man plenty of character. The finished piece can be used as a beautiful and unusual piece of garden art. The clay we use is soft & pliable, and, when it is fired it is a stunning white. The size of the green man is approximately 30cm in diameter. Includes white clay, 2 firings, green glaze, collection from the shop 4-6 weeks after the workshop, maximum number is 6 so there is plenty of personal space to work & 1-1 tuition & guidance. tea/ coffee.



Make a sunny Easter display of paper/card daffodils with Julie Carman on Friday 8th March, 2024 10.30 - 12.30 or 1.30 - 3.30pm. £15.00pp 6 places at each session. Julie will show you how to make the flowers and attach them to the stalks and there will be enough material to take home after the class to make more to complete the bunch of daffodils.
