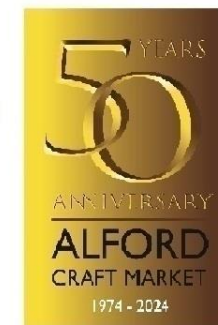
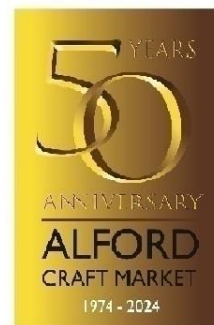

Make two 5" x 2" colourful hanging fused glass fish with glass artist Amanda Brown on Saturday 6th July, 2024 10.30 - 1pm £45.00pp. These will look great in a bathroom! There will be lots of different coloured glass to choose from. Your 2 fish will be fused in our big kiln and ready to collect from the Alford Craft Market Shop about a week later, or we can post it to you for a small extra charge. 7 places.

Make a 25 x 20cms stained glass panel with tutor Claire Hart on Thursday 11th July, 2024 10.30 - 4.30pm. £72.50pp. 6 places at each session - includes all materials. Different designs to choose from. This is the perfect introduction to leaded stained glass covering the basic principles of making a leaded stained glass panel. Students will learn how to cut glass and assemble it into the lead framework, soldering the joints to complete the project. Not suitable for pregnant ladies. Please note you will be standing for most of the day. Tea and coffee provided - please bring a packed lunch.

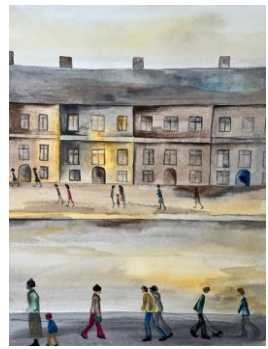

Make a Sterling Silver Spinning Ring with Kate Snookes on Saturdays July 13th or December 14th, 2024 10.30 - 3.30pm. £88.50pp. 8 places. Come and make your very own, unique Sterling Silver spinner ring with 1, 2 or 3 spinning rings. There is an endless choice of patterns and you can add stones, a heart or star or just leave them just silver. Your ring, your way. We will be using traditional silversmithing techniques, all tool use and materials included in the price, suitable for absolute beginners and above, all welcome. Tea or coffee included - please bring a packed lunch.



Paint a Watercolour Industrial Scene in the style of L. S. Lowry with Amina Sly-Khan on Sunday 14th July, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm £40.00pp. The session starts with a tea/coffee and introductions. We learn a little about the artist L.S.Lowry before moving on to sketching out the industrial landscape. I will go through Lowry's palette and we will paint the watercolour landscape with this in mind. You will use a number of watercolour techniques, wet on wet, wet on dry, blooms & back runs. The watercolour is completed on hot pressed watercolour paper & we will be using block watercolours. The session is three hours, all materials, tea & coffee is included. There is plenty of 1-1 guidance as it is a small class.

Make a Green Man Plaque with Purple Meadow Arts & Crafts on Saturday 3rd August, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm £45.00pp. This is a 3hr Powertex workshop. You will be helped & guided to make & design your very own weatherproof fabric sculpted Greenman plaque. These are ideal for home or garden. Everything required to make your Green Man will be provided. You will first design your piece using materials, fabric hardener and embellishments. Whilst we dry your work ready for painting you can sit back and relax with Tea or Coffee. Once your Green Man is ready you will have a choice of colours to bring him to life. You will be shown a dry brush painting technique by one of our certified tutors.



Learn to paint Canal Art roses with Stuart Garfoot on Sundays 4th or 11th August, 2024 10.30 - 2.30pm. £40.00pp.

6 places at each session. Includes use of all materials, paints and equipment. You will be guided through the stages of painting canal art flowers and you will create an item to take home. We will practice brushes strokes, leaves and tendrils and flower backgrounds on a varnished board so you can wipe off and practice as many times as you like. Then



1. Draw your design
2. Paint leaves and tendrils and daisy backgrounds
3. Paint leaf veins and then backgrounds for roses and daisies
4. Add petals for the roses and daisies
