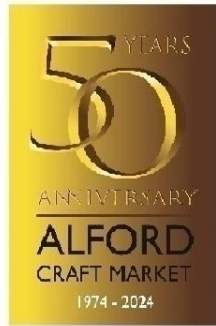
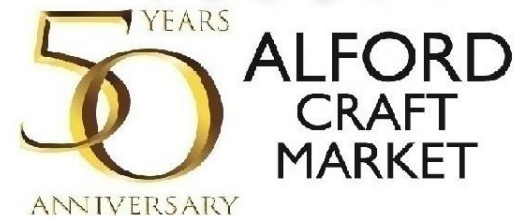
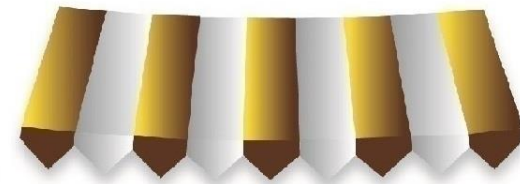
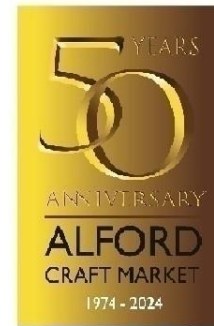
Botanical Casting workshops with Clare Towers of The Foxglove Tree on Sundays 8th or 29th September, 2024 10.30 - 2.30pm. £65.00pp. Join me for a workshop in which you will learn the art of botanical casting. Capturing all the intricate details of seasonal plants and flowers in raised relief. Choose from Sundays 8th or 29th September, 2024. 10:30-2:30pm 10 places each session. During the workshop you will learn how to prepare the clay for casting. Select the correct seasonal flora and how to arrange and create a unique design. Techniques for pressing different flowers. Removal of the flora. Mixing and pouring plaster. You will also learn how to sand and finish your cast at home. You will leave the workshop with your own unique cast panel to be proudly displayed in your home. There will be a lunch break during the class to allow for the cast to set. Please bring a pack lunch. All materials are provided. Although an apron is supplied, you will be working with clay and plaster so old clothes are recommended. A variety of seasonal plants and flowers will be supplied, you are more than welcome to bring your own if you wish to incorporate something special from your own garden.

Make a Green Man Plaque with Purple Meadow Arts & Crafts on Saturday 3rd August, 2024 10.30 - 1.30pm

£45.00pp. This is a 3hr Powertex workshop. You will be helped & guided to make & design your very own weatherproof fabric sculpted Greenman plaque. These are ideal for home or garden. Everything required to make your Green Man will be provided. You will first design your piece using materials, fabric hardener and embellishments. Whilst we dry your work ready for painting you can sit back and relax with Tea or Coffee. Once your Green Man is ready you will have a choice of colours to bring him to life. You will be shown a dry brush painting technique by one of our certified tutors.



Learn to paint Canal Art roses with Stuart Garfoot on Sundays 4th or 11th August, 2024 10.30 - 2.30pm. £40.00pp.

6 places at each session. Includes use of all materials, paints and equipment. You will be guided through the stages of painting canal art flowers and you will create an item to take home. We will practice brushes strokes, leaves and tendrils and flower backgrounds on a varnished board so you can wipe off and practice as many times as you like. Then

1. Draw your design
2. Paint leaves and tendrils and daisy backgrounds
3. Paint leaf veins and then backgrounds for roses and daisies
4. Add petals for the roses and daisies

Make a terracotta and glass mosaic bird bath with tutor Claire Hart on Thursday 15th August, 2024 10.30 - 5.30pm. £62.50pp. All materials provided. 6 places. Size approx. 30cms in diameter. Students will design their bird bath from a selection of patterns and then will learn how to cut glass/grind glass to form the main elements and fill in the background. This is an ideal project to practice glass cutting skills and make something fabulous for the garden. You will need to be able to stand for the morning. There is an option to grout it yourself at home (materials provided and tutorial online), or the tutor will do it for you. Tea and coffee supplied - please bring a packed lunch.
