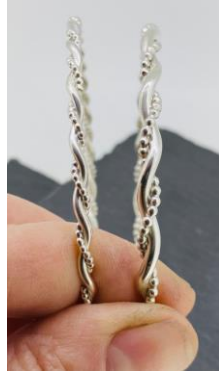

The next session is Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February, 10.30 – 12.30. This exciting community project will be led by the Alford Knitting Nannas. There are approx. 100 buildings to knit! Come along and join in!

Pottery sessions with tutor Charlotte Lauriston-Norris on the **2nd Tuesday of each month in 2025** 10.30 - 1.30pm. £45.00pp. January and February are fully booked so the first available date is Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2025. 6 places per session. Have go throwing a pot on the wheel and make a ceramic dish in this combination throwing and hand-building session. You will be guided by an experienced, qualified teacher to create 2 unique pieces exploring a range of textures and patterns. You will also get to have a go on the potter's wheel - make sure you bring an apron and wear old clothes! You have the option to take your makes home with you and paint them when dry or have them glazed at my studio in Louth for a small extra charge. All materials, tea and coffee included.

Garden bird pencil crayon workshop with Louise Earnshaw on Friday 31st January 2025 10.30 - 1.30pm. £25.00pp. Come and join this step-by-step workshop learning how to draw garden birds using layers of coloured pencil and mark making to capture detail and texture. No previous experience is required for this as demonstrations are given throughout by our experienced artist and teacher Louise Earnshaw. All equipment and resources will be provided alongside tea and coffee.



Paint the Northern Lights in Watercolour with artist Karin Christensen on Sunday February 2nd, 2025, 10.30 - 3.30pm. £45.00pp. Join me for a day of painting the magic Aurora Borealis in watercolours. We will paint two different designs in a wet in wet style, using high quality watercolours on professional artist paper to achieve the best results. Practice blending the paint and let it flow into beautiful vivid colours. Take home paintings, new skills and inspiration. Limited to 9 participants per session, ensuring you get individual feedback. Make a tall ceramic toadstool from stoneware clay with Karen Raithby of Pentangle Pottery on Saturday 8th February, 2025 10.30 - 12.30pm. £35.00pp. Includes all materials, firing and glazes. Karen is a one-woman pottery, handmaking whimsical work inspired by folk law, legend and magic. A great way to relax and create something special. Work is processed and returned to the Alford Craft Market Shop for collection 3 weeks after the workshop.

**One the same day in the afternoon:** - Make a small 14cms in diameter stoneware clay Green Man/Woman plaque with Karen Raithby of Pentangle Pottery on Saturday 8th February, 2025 1.30 - 3.30pm. £35.00pp.

Mindful Nature sketching workshop (Green Sketching) with Louise Earnshaw on Friday 7th February 2025 10.30 - 12.30pm. £25.00pp. Green sketching is an art movement that is helping to make the incredible benefits of sketching nature (which include mental wellbeing, nature connection, improved memory, focus and observation) accessible to all. Led by Louise Earnshaw, a Lincs. based artist and green sketching ambassador, the two-hour session will enable you to immerse yourself in the processes of observing nature alongside learning skills and techniques. You can use these over and over in your own time to benefit from slowing down in nature and observing its beauty. All specialist materials are provided, and you will be given a mini sketchbook to take home and continue your green sketching journey.
