Make a March Hare with Jayne Allenby on Saturday 29th March, 2025 10am - 4pm. £50.00pp. Join Jayne Allenby to make a March hare. Made from mohair using traditional bear making techniques. All fabrics, fillings etc included in the price. A pattern will be provided for you to make his coat at home. A sewing machine is required, and there will be elements of hand sewing. Limited to 6 places. Tea and Coffee provided - please bring a packed lunch.

Paint with Alcohol inks with Purple Meadow Arts & Crafts on Saturday 5th April, 2025 10.30 - 1pm. £35.00pp. At this class you will learn how to manoeuvre/control the flow of your alcohol inks using an air blowing technique. We will look at composition and colour blends. You will practice this technique before you create your own piece of art to take home with you. Your finished piece will be A4 in size, mounted on to a good quality mount board with a frame insert.

Pottery sessions with tutor Charlotte Lauriston-Norris on the **2nd Tuesday of each month in 2025** 10.30 - 1.30pm. £45.00pp. February and March are fully booked so the first available date is **Tuesday 8th April, 2025**. 6 places per session. Have go throwing a pot on the wheel and make a ceramic dish in this combination throwing and hand-building session. You will be guided by an experienced, qualified teacher to create 2 unique pieces exploring a range of textures and patterns. You will also get to have a go on the potter's wheel - make sure you bring an apron and wear old clothes! You have the option to take your makes home with you and paint them when dry or have them glazed at my studio in Louth for a small extra charge. All materials, tea and coffee included.

Make a Macrame wall hanging owl with tutor Sandra Ford on Thursday 13th March, 2025 10.30 - 2.30pm. £30.00pp. Do you have a basic understanding of macrame? If so, then this project is just for you! Join macrame tutor Sandra Ford, who will guide you through this project from start to finish. Learn to use your macrame skills to make this very cute hanging owl in just a few hours. Don't worry if you are a little rusty, Sandra will help guide you through the project every step of the way. If you want to make something exciting and unique then come and join us and have a go! Made from 100% cotton cord. 6 places. Includes all materials, tea and coffee. Bring a packed lunch.



Create a 5-flag line of weatherproof Garden Bunting using Powertex on Saturday 22nd March, 2025 10.30 - 1.30pm. £50.00pp. In this fun filled and relaxed 3-hour workshop you will be creating your beautiful weatherproof Garden Bunting, by using an environmentally friendly fabric hardener, (please wear appropriate clothing) materials and embellishments. You will be shown how to create texture and layers that will give it, its own individual look. After you have finished creating your Bunting, it will then be dried whilst you relax with a cup of tea or coffee. You will have a choice of colours to paint your work and bring it to life. This will be done by using a dry brush painting technique. Jill and Karl who are both qualified Powertex tutors will guide you through the workshop and help you achieve a piece to add colour and interest to your garden.

Pottery Fish Planter 1.30 – 4pm. with Amina Sly Khan on Sunday 23rd March, 2025. £45pp. Using earthenware clay, you will hand build a fish planter using several pottery techniques. I take your pottery to my studio where it dries out completely. Once this is dried out, I fire it to a biscuit stage. I will then glaze and glaze fire it again. The finished piece is returned to Alford Craft Market where you can collect it. I'll text you beforehand to inform you of the day it is ready.



Make an arrangement of stained-glass tulips or a cheerful stained glass Easter egg mobile with Bev and John Chappell from Crafted Wood & Glass on Sunday 16th March 2025. **9am to 1pm**. Celebrate the Spring and enjoy a half day making an arrangement of 3 stained glass tulips, set in a handsome Oak or Sapele wooden stand (approx. 25cm h x 12cm w). You will gain experience of cutting your tulip flowers from your chosen glass, grinding and foiling the glass, soldering and finishing them with wire stems. **2pm - 6pm**. Make a cheerful stained glass Easter egg mobile, comprising of 3 Easter Eggs from a choice of patterns and glass. The eggs will be hung from a wooden mobile (overall size when complete approx. 16cm W x 17cm H). Once you have completed this task, there may also be time to make a further selection of individual eggs (each approx. 7cm H x 5cm W) suitable to hang independently from your Easter tree or perhaps as an alternative gift to a chocolate egg. You will gain experience of cutting your eggs from your chosen glass, grinding and foiling the glass, soldering and finishing them with wire or ribbon. Maximum 8 places. (Get a 5% discount on each class if attending both classes). All with instruction and help from Bev and John Chappell from Crafted Wood & Glass. Please wear closed toe shoes. Due to the lead content in the solder, the course is not suitable if you are pregnant or breast feeding.
