Learn to Crochet! 3 relaxed and fun sessions with tutor Pam Barnell on Wednesdays 10th, 17th and 24th November, 2021. Ideal for beginners or as a refresher. 10.30 – 1.30pm £50pp

Over 3 weeks you will learn the basics of crochet, including terminology & reading a crochet pattern. You will use different stitches to make a case for your crochet hooks, a scarf, a granny square & some bunting. 4 places. All materials including hooks provided.

Make a Powertex weatherproof Xmas wreath with Purple Meadow Crafts on Thursday 11th November, 2021 10.30 – 1.30pm £38pp 6 places. This is a lovely relaxed festive workshop where you will make your own original Xmas wreath. Your tutor will guide you through the process of using a fabric hardener along with various natural materials and embellishments. You will design and add texture to your wreath then add colours of your choice. All materials provided and your wreath will be ready to go outside after 3 weeks. Tea, coffee and biscuits provided.



A sterling silver 3 stacking rings class with Kathryn Snookes BaHons on Friday 12th November, 2021 £68pp 10.30 - 2.30pm 6 places. Come and make for yourself or a friend 3 sterling silver stacking rings all individually different. Make them all the same size and wear them all together, or make different sizes for different fingers. You will be using traditional silversmithing techniques and tools. All materials and tool use included in the price. Tea and coffee supplied. Bring a packed lunch if you need one.

Layer, Bond, Stitch & Burn! With textile artist Karen Lane on Monday 15th November, 2021 10.30 – 4.30pm £40 all materials included 5 places. A fun, experimental workshop when we will get creative with a variety of synthetic fabrics. Students can use their own design or follow an example. Techniques such as cutting, layering, bonding, foiling and free motion stitching then we will burn away our background using a soldering iron and heat too to leave a beautiful lace effect. No previous experience necessary, all materials included. Please bring your sewing machine with a free motion foot and a spool of black 100% cotton thread. Tea, coffee and biscuits provided – please bring a packed lunch.
