You will use different stitches to make a case for your crochet hooks, a scarf, a granny square and some bunting. All materials, including hooks provided.

Make Lutradur leaves with textile artist Karen Lane on Saturday 12th February, 2022 10.30 – 3.30pm 6 places £45pp Includes Lutradur fabric, tea/coffee & biscuits. In this workshop we will create realistic looking leaves using Lutradur, an exciting, heat manipulated fabric that can be cut with scissors or a soldering iron, painted, stitched & distressed using a heat gun to form the leaves. The leaves can be framed or be included on decorative wreaths, brooches, cards etc. Please bring a packed lunch, your fabric paints and your sewing machine with a free motion foot & thread which must be 100% cotton, rayon or viscose – not polyester as this will burn! Suitable for all abilities.
