**On the Potter's Wheel Pottery Taster Sessions monthly on Saturday or Tuesday mornings. 10.30am – 1.30pm £45pp.** Saturdays, 10<sup>th</sup> September, 8<sup>th</sup> October, 12<sup>th</sup> November, 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2022. Tuesdays 16<sup>th</sup> August, 20<sup>th</sup> September, 18<sup>th</sup> October, 15<sup>th</sup> November, 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2022. Learn how to work with clay, centre a piece of clay and throw a bowl(s). Tea and coffee provided – please bring your own apron and towel. All materials and firing provided. 4 places at each session. **Groups welcome.**

**YOUNG POTTERS WHEEL WORKSHOP School Holiday Pottery Session with Alan Hill on Thursday 28th July 10:30 - 1:30pm £30.00pp.** A clay workshop where you will enjoy learning how to make up to 3 bowls and beakers. Alan, your DBS cleared pottery tutor, will give a brief pottery wheel demonstration and give you an opportunity to have a go on the pottery wheel. For 10-17 years olds, parents are welcome to stay (there is an adjoining lounge). Includes all materials, glazing and firing. Limited to 5 places. Your pots will be ready for collection the following month from the shop.



**Introduction to Raku Pottery workshop on Sunday 31st July, 2022 10.30 - 2.30pm £76.00pp.**

This visually exciting and very fast way of firing pottery with beautiful and surprising results will be led by Alan Hill of Aby Ceramics, who will provide 3 pieces of pottery ready for you to glaze & fire. Raku involves removing pottery from the kiln while at bright red heat & placing it into containers with combustible materials. Once the materials ignite the containers are closed. This produces an intense reduction atmosphere, which affects the colours in the glazes. The drastic thermal shock can result in the desirable crazing of the surface. Wear suitable clothing for the weather, robust shoes (no sandals), cotton clothes, tie back long hair and bring a packed lunch - you will be provided with safety wear. Limited to 6 places and maybe weather dependent as the kiln is outdoors.



**YOUNG POTTERS HANDMADE MUG WORKSHOP School Holiday Pottery Session with Alan Hill on Thursday 4th August 10:30 - 1:30 £30.00pp.** A clay workshop where you will enjoy learning how to make a pair of cups or mugs.
