You will be shown how to thread the machine, sew your first stitches, tension adjustment/ solving tension problems, the uses of different machine feet, basic sewing techniques, zip insertion, plus other things. On the second day you will be shown different interfacings, their use, and using one, make a make up bag like the one above in a fabric you choose from a selection on the day. Everything provided, just bring a pair of sharp scissors. A sewing machine will be available for each student to use. Each student will be given a small sewing kit to use and take home. 

Stitch & Burn! with textile artist Karen Lane on August, 2022 10.30 - 4.30pm. £46.00pp. All

led. 8 places. This is going to be a fun, experimental session where we will be creative with a variety of synthetic materials. You can use their own design or simply follow one of the examples supplied. Techniques to be used will include cutting, layering, bonding, foiling and free motion stitching. Finally we will burn away our background using a soldering iron and heat tool to leave a beautiful lace like effect. No previous experience necessary, all materials included. You will learn to cut leather, use various decoration techniques including stamping and dye, fit a buckle with stitch or rivet, and make a keeper. There is a choice of belt and collar widths and buckles to choose from, students can decorate as they please and choose from a selection of colours to dye their belt or collar.



Make a Shoulder Bag plus matching make up bag with Sylvia Turner on Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th September 2022 10.30 - 4.30pm each day. 5 places. £55.00pp. Make this bag

plus matching make up bag, in a relaxing atmosphere, 5 places. All fabrics, interfacing, stiffening, cotton, zip(s) etc included. You need to be confident in the use of a sewing machine. Bring your machine or use one of ours by emailing us. Instructions given on zip fitting. Bring your own dressmaking scissors and sewing kit. Make a solid Sterling silver or 9ct Gold facet bangle with Kate Snookes Friday 9th September, 2022 10.30 - 2.30pm £82.50pp silver - £450.00pp 9ct gold. Come and make yourself or someone else this beautiful, solid Sterling silver or 9ct Yellow Gold bangle. We will be using traditional silver smithing tools and techniques, all tool use and materials included in the price, suitable for absolute beginners and above, all welcome.

Learn to Crochet! 3 relaxed and fun sessions with our tutor Pam Barnell. Ideal for absolute beginners or as a refresher. Fridays 9th, 16th and 23rd September, 2022 10.30 - 1.30pm.

Students will design their bird bath from a selection of patterns and then will learn how to cut glass/grind glass to form the main elements and fill in the background. This is an ideal project to practice glass cutting skills and make something fabulous for the garden. You will need to stand all morning. There is an option to grout it yourself at home or tutor will do it.



Make a 15 x 11cms Autumnal Leaf in stained glass and copper foiling with Caron King on Saturday 17th September, 2022 10.30 - 3.30pm £65.00pp Includes all use of tools and materials.

Make your Autumnal leaf in a choice of greens and browns. You will learn to score and break the glass, then learn the skills of cutting, grinding, soldering and finishing your leaf. Tea and coffee provided - please bring a packed lunch.



Make a 12cms Glass Mosaic ball/garden stake for your garden with tutor Claire Hart on Saturday 24th September, 2022 10.30 - 3pm £37.50pp Max 6 places, Includes all materials. Make

a lovely mosaic gazing ball to hang or go on a garden cane. Students will learn how to cut glass and attach it to their ball to complete their project. An ideal introduction to mosaics, cutting glass, adhesives and grouting. Info- sitting all day, please bring a packed lunch. Grouting demo (students can take home materials to grout at home or tutor will do it).
