Come along and learn the basics of copper foiling Tiffany style. You will make your rainbow kisses using the many colours available. You will learn the skills of cutting, grinding and soldering. Tea, coffee and biscuits provided – just bring along a packed lunch.



Acrylic Painting workshop for beginners and intermediates with Carey Jones Friday 26th July, 2019 10.30 – 4pm £25pp Come along and paint with acrylics – bright, vibrant & very versatile they can be used in a number of ways to create a 'watercolour' or 'oil' effect & can be overpainted almost straight away making it very easy to correct any mistakes or improve things you don't like! How about painting your pet, house or favourite landscape – bring photos/images with you. Tea, coffee & biscuits provided. Please bring a packed lunch. 10.30 – 3.30pm £40pp Spend the day trying out this wonderful technique. Working with hot wax on fabric you will create a range of designs/pictures and then add dyes to bring them to life. This workshop is appropriate for ages 16+, all materials are supplied but please bring an apron, a couple of plastic bags and your packed lunch.



Oil Painting - Trees in a landscape with Bridget Jones on Monday 24th June, 2019 10.30 – 3.30pm £47pp – 6 places. This workshop is suitable for those who would like to paint with oils. Make these pretty and practical 3” x 10” fused glass plant stakes with glass artist Matt Sorrell on Wednesday 26th June, 2019 2.30 – 5pm 4 places

£39pp. With Matt’s help you will design your own plant stakes – ideal for presents or for your own home. Suitable for all abilities. Includes use of all equipment and all materials. Lots of colours to choose from! Your plant stakes will be fired in our big kiln and ready to collect about a week after the class or can be posted for a small extra charge.



Beginners Daytime 4 week Sewing Group with Sandy Loosley on Mondays 1st July, 8th July, 15th July and 22nd July, 2019 10.30 – 12.30 £26pp or £7.50 per session – start at any time during the 4 week course. Bring your own sewing project or start a new one. With Sandy’s guidance you will learn new sewing techniques each week to make your own clothes and house decorations in a friendly and fun group. 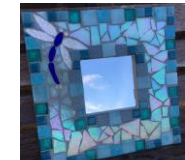
Changing a Photograph’s Atmosphere, Seasons and Content with Anne Barnham, on 5th July 2019 10.30am till 3.30pm £25 per person

Choose from the following projects:- Coasters: Make up to 4 10 x 10cm coasters, a square slumped dish 13 x 13cm which will be fired once on a full fuse and then a 2nd time on a slump firing to achieve its 3D shape, or a 30 x 8cm colourful beach huts piece. There will be a great selection of coloured sheet and glass frits. The pieces will be fired and ready for collection about a week later. Suitable for beginners as well as those who have some experience with glass.
