Painting Perspective and People with Anne Barnham
Thursday 12th November 2020, 10.30 – 3.30 £ 25pp

There is no need to be anxious about 'Perspective' I have a very simple, clear way of explaining it to you so that it makes sense and you can happily incorporate buildings and streets into your paintings. I am going to show you how to populate a painting, people in a street, down a lane or in a park. Please bring your usual painting items. Brushes, paints, tissues, water pot, paper, and pencil.



An exciting and intense introduction to the ancient art of Beadmaking.
Tuesdays 27th October, 10th November or Saturday 12th December, 2020
£40pp. Using coloured glass rods and a very hot flame you can make big or small hole beads to fit a bracelet, a collar, a pendant or a necklace. Leather aprons and eye protection provided. Please wear cotton clothes and tie back long hair. 3 places available at each session.

Make a Powertex Statue on Friday 13th November,
2020 10.30 – 3.30pm 6 places £70pp.

This is a full day workshop where you will create a statue, a unique piece of art. You will build a base structure for your statue & use Powertex with different fabrics to dress it. You decide on the style & colours. All materials supplied. Once your statue has dried you will use a dry brushing technique to add colour and bring it to life.



2 places left - Make 6 springs of mistletoe in
stained glass and copper foiling with Caron
King on Monday 2nd November, 2020 10.30 –
3.30pm £50pp. 6 places. Either have them as single sprigs, 2 small bunches of springs or a large bunch. Come along for the day and learn the basics of copper foiling Tiffany style. There will be lots of colours to choose from. You will learn new skills in cutting, grinding and soldering. All materials and use of tools included.



Layer, bond, Stitch & Burn! With textile artist
Karen Lane on Monday 16th November, 2020

10.30 – 4.30pm £40pp all materials included. 6 places. This is going to be a fun, experimental workshop where we will be getting creative with a variety of synthetic fabrics. Students can use their own design or simply follow one of the examples shown at the class.



Techniques to be used will include cutting, layering, bonding, foiling & free motion stitching. Finally we will burn away our background using a soldering iron & heat tool to leave a beautiful lace like effect. No previous experience necessary. Please bring your sewing machine with a free motion foot & a spool of 100% cotton thread.
